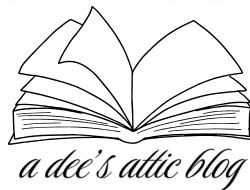

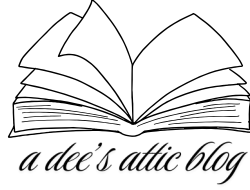
August 4th
