System Overview - Capability

- Large Conference Room
 - Is equipped for audio/visual presentations
 - Can feed the presentation to the small conference room and the library lounge reading area
- Small Conference Room
 - Is equipped for stand alone visual presentations
 - Can receive A/V content from Large Conference Room
- Library Lounge Area
 - HDMI A/V Connection for Mondo Pad use
- Mondo Pad
 - Mobile
 - “Just a Giant Tablet”

System Overview - Equipment

- Large Conference Room
 - Projector
 - Touch Screen Wall Remote Control
 - Sound System
 - Camera
 - Wall Plate for A/V Connections
- Small Conference Room
 - Sony Flat Screen Monitor
 - Touch Screen Wall Remote Control
 - Ceiling Speakers and Volume Control
 - Wall Plate for A/V Connections
- Lounge Area
 - Wall Plate for Mondo Pad Connection

Making A Presentation from the Large Conference Room

Step 1

Connect User Electronics to the system

- Wired Connections use Wall Plate
- Right side provides direct connection to Projector using VGA or HDMI
- Left side connects to A/V Cabinet
- 3.5mm left jack is for audio input
- Wireless Connections use LiteShow

Step 2

Use touch screen wall remote to lower viewing screen

Step 3

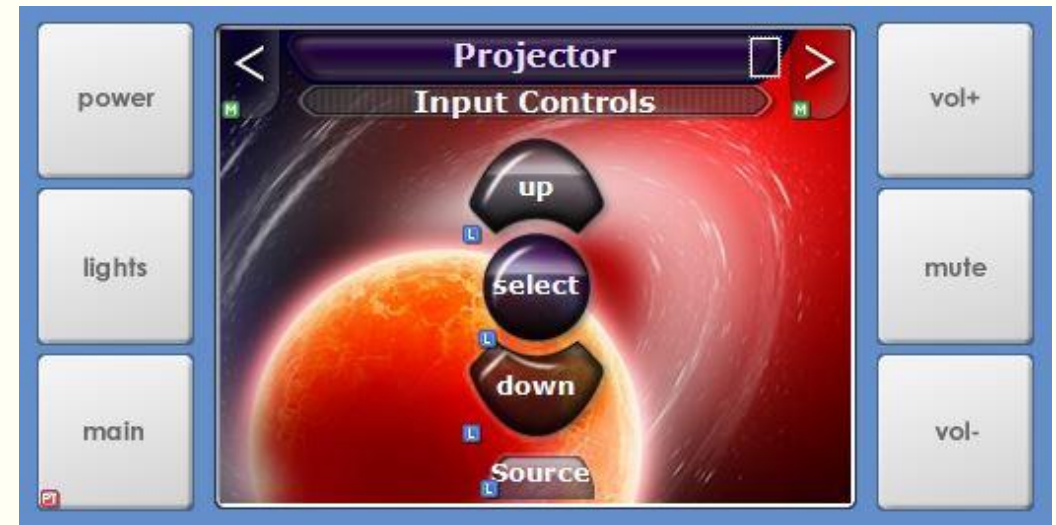
Use touch screen wall remote to turn on projector



Making A Presentation from the Large Conference Room

Step 4

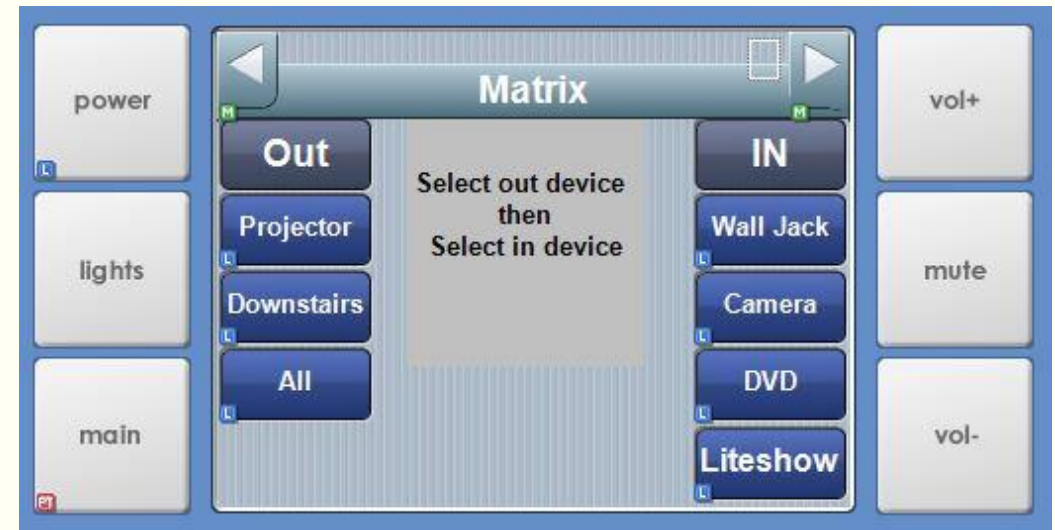
- Using the Projector Power Screen, navigate to Projector Input Controls using the arrows in the upper corners
- Press Source Button, Select projector input Using the “Up/Down” Buttons then “Select”



Making A Presentation from the Large Conference Room

Step 5

- Use touch screen wall remote to select Matrix source
- Select out device (projector) then select in device (wall jack or Liteshow)



Making A Presentation from the Large Conference Room

Step 6 – Microphone Use

- Choose either hand held or lavalier microphone from the cabinet
 - Press Power Button on Microphone to turn on
 - **Green** LED indicates good battery power



Making A Presentation from the Large or Small Conference Room using Liteshow Wireless

- Select Liteshow from the Matrix menu
 - Use laptop or tablet to connect to Liteshow wireless network
- Follow directions on projector or TV screen to complete connection using system generated access code

Making A Presentation from the Small Conference Room

Step 1

Connect User Electronics to the system

- Wired connection use HDMI plug
- Wireless connection use LiteShow

*note: jack 73 and 74 are Library Network connections and not part of the A/V system



Making A Presentation from the Small Conference Room

Step 2

- Use touch screen wall remote to select TV for viewing
 - Turn power on using the TV Main Control Screen



Making A Presentation from the Small Conference Room

Step 3

- From TV Main Control Screen select right arrow to access TV Inputs
 - Select HDMI 2
 - Presentation volume can be controlled by vol+ and vol-
